


Focus on assessing only the Cognitive Domain PLO because it is a written exam oriented assessment

20% OF QUESTION HAVE TAXONOMY LEVELS 1 AND 2



70% OF QUESTION HAVE TAXONOMY LEVELS 3 AND 4
